## CONCLUSIONS

- Barrier Spray is an effective weapon
- In some areas we made significant progress
- Rain events need to be looked at in advance if possible (Long range forecast)
- Coordinate with Parks Dept about sprinklers
- The six week rotation seems OK for now
- Good response from the public
- Mule and sprayer accepted by the public
