Overview:

Chatham County maintains a comprehensive mosquito control program with a fiscal year operating budget of approximately \$4 million. The program serves the entirety of Chatham County including unincorporated Chatham County and its eight municipalities, an area of approximately 440 square miles with 290,000 residents. The Chatham County Mosquito Control Department operates with 30 staff positions. The Department maintains four helicopters that are the primary tool for mosquito control efforts and surveillance in remote areas. Mosquito Control aircraft are also used to support local police and fire departments, Emergency Management, and a number of other county departments and agencies. Professional development is strongly encouraged and the department's staff actively participate in state, regional and national mosquito control association organizations.

Job Summary:

- Plans and directs a comprehensive, cost effective mosquito control program that complies with federal and state regulations, protects Chatham County residents from nuisance mosquitoes, and minimizes the threat of mosquito-borne disease.
- Essential functions include overseeing mosquito control operations; supervising, directing and evaluating assigned staff; formulating and maintaining the departmental budget; communicating with the media, external agencies and the general public regarding mosquito control activities; and maintaining a current knowledge of applicable laws and regulations.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in Entomology, Public Health or related field required.
- Supplemented by five (5) or more years' experience in mosquito control, personnel management, and project management.
- Preference is given to candidates that possess and maintain a valid Georgia Pesticide Applicator's License in the following pest control categories: Public Health, Mosquito Control, Aerial, Demonstration and Research, Right-of-Way, and Aquatic.
